
RE: AB 352 exempts peace officers from payment of fees for a permit to carry a concealed firearm

Dear Chairman Hansen and Assembly Judiciary Committee,

The Nevada Firearms Coalition Strongly Supports this bill. As peace officers are already certified to carry a concealed firearm and if they become a prohibited possessor per NRS 202.360 they lose their peace officer certification and employment, payment for a background check seems excessive. Clarifying restrictions on open carry of firearms and eliminating the Clark County Handgun Registration program are all beneficial components of this legislation.
