Dear Chair Yeager;

The Nevada Firearms Coalition **STRONGLY SUPPORTS** the passage of this bill.

The State of Nevada has a strong and enforceable concealed firearm permit system that allows qualified and vetted persons to carry a handgun concealed. Under current law, persons exercising their rights under this permit are precluded from entering onto the property of a private or public school or child care facility, or on property of the Nevada System of Higher Education. Many of these people work in the community and travel to and from school or college on a daily basis. The current law basically denies them the ability to carry concealed as they are not allowed to enter these “safe zones” and must park or drop off their children in unsecure areas not on school or campus property. In order to comply with current law, a person who carries concealed with the NV state permit cannot drop or pick up their children from school. This proposed legislation allows for that ability within certain identified legislation. This is a common sense bill that is consistent with other provisions regarding concealed carry.
